TRANSHIPMENT OF PASSENGERS AT LES ESCOUMINS PILOTAGE STATION

The Laurentian Pilotage Authority offers the possibility of transhipping passengers at its Les Escoumins station. To meet the criteria of safety and those of the Canada Border Services Agency, we ask <u>all</u> potential passengers to send the "Request for transhipment aboard a Laurentian Pilotage Authority's pilot-boat at Les Escoumins" form to our offices at least 48 hours before transhipment. Identity documents must also be provided.

Procedure :

At least 48 hours prior to transhipment	
1.	Send the « Request for transhipment » form with required identity document by
	e-mail at : passager-esc@apl.gc.ca
2.	If the ship is not cleared, take the necessary steps to have your Canada Border
	Services Agency's "Request for authorization to board a vessel" form approved and
	return it to us
When boarding	
1.	Arrive at the station at least 45 minutes in advance
2.	Meet the pilot-boat's captain and show him the duly authorized form(s) as well as
	identity document
3.	When the captain gives you permission to board the pilot-boat, put on your
	individual flotation device
In case of cancellation	
1.	Notify us by e-mail at : passager-esc@apl.gc.ca
	NB : Failure to notify us of the cancellation in writing shall result in transhipment
	fees being charged to the passenger

It is <u>MANDATORY</u> that any passenger transhipment aboard a non-duty paid ship be authorized by the Canada Border Services Agency. Failure to present duly authorized documents or valid identity documents will result in the transhipment being refused.

The Laurentian Pilotage Authority reserves the right to reject any transfer that has not been submitted by the required notice of 48 hours.
