



16 - POLICY ON DOCKING IN DISTRICT NO. 2

1. Objectives of the Policy

The purpose of this Policy is to set out certain specific rules for docking services in District No. 2.

2. Background

For some ships, given the physical, hydrographic, climatic, hydrological, or geographical characteristics of the ports of District No. 2, it is important to assign rested, familiar, and specialized pilots for dockside maneuvers.

3. Policy Statements and Requirements

- 3.1 The CPBSL makes available to the Authority a list of pilots who specialize in docking maneuvers to carry out, in the circumstances provided for in this Policy or at the request of the owner, the captain or the ship's agent, berthing, casting off and alongside movement of ships.
- 3.2 A docking pilot will be provided by the CPBSL and assigned by the Authority free of charge when the owner, captain or agent of the ship has not specifically requested it in all the following cases:
 - 3.2.1 At the port of Gros-Cacouna, on arrival or departure
If it is a ship of 17,500 dwt or more, or a length of 160 m or more.
 - 3.2.2 At the port of Pointe-au-Pic, on arrival
If it is a ship of 17,500 dwt or more, or a passenger ship over 100 m.
 - 3.2.3 At the port of Grande Anse, on arrival
If it is a ship of 17,500 dwt or more
 - 3.2.4 At the port of Port-Alfred, on arrival
If it is a ship of 50,000 dwt or more or a passenger ship over 100 m.
 - 3.2.5 At the Port of Quebec
As relief on arrival of all ships at Sainte-Pétronille, except ships whose length is less than 65 m
